The Lisle Woman's Club would like you to create a real or imaginary story that focuses on these experience and include a strong woman who has influenced this story.

### Rules:

- Entries must be typewritten, double-spaced, printed on one side only with minimum margins of 1" (one inch) on all four sides of 8 ½" x 11" paper.
- Maximum of 2,000 words.
- The Six Traits of Writing will be used in the judging of the Youth Writing Contest.
- Each entry must include Entry Form and the signed Parent Permission Form.

Entries MUST have the following in the top right hand corner of EACH page.

- Name of author, grade in school, email address, mailing address, telephone number, and title of piece.
- Also include the following: Lisle Woman's Club, 5th District, GFWC Illinois
- Include the wording Division I for 6th graders or Division II for 7th & 8th graders

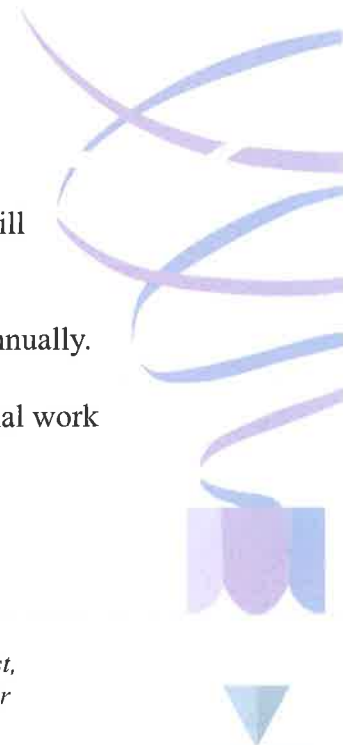
### Eligibility:

- Entrants must be in 6th - 8th grade during the 2020-2021 school year.
- Entrants must be a legal resident of zip code 60532.
- Only one entry per person will be accepted in this Contest; all subsequent entries will be disqualified.
- Only single author stories qualify (no co-authored stories).
- Authors must be of amateur status. Earnings from writing must not exceed \$500 annually.
- All entries must be in English.
- Entries may not have been published prior to the competition and must be an original work of the author.
